Question 1

- **B1** Je vais le regarder ce soir. or Le film moved as le before the infinitive is correct
- **Answer: Je vais le regarder ce soir.**

Question 2

- **B1** Je lui ai donne un cadeau. with lui correctly used for a Sara and placed before the auxiliary
- **Answer: Je lui ai donne un cadeau.**

Question 3

- **B1** Il les lit tous les soirs. with les correctly used for les livres and placed before the conjugated verb lit
- **Answer: Il les lit tous les soirs.**

Question 4

- **M1** Elle l'a mangée hier. with l' correctly replacing la tarte and placed before the auxiliary
- **A1** past participle agreement: mangée with extra e to agree with la tarte (feminine singular) is required
- **Answer: Elle l'a mangée hier.**

Question 5

- **M1** Nous les avons vendus hier soir. with les correctly replacing les billets and placed before the auxiliary
- **A1** past participle agreement: vendus with -s to agree masculine plural is required
- **Answer: Nous les avons vendus hier soir.**

Question 6

- **B1** Je vais lui téléphoner ce soir. with lui correctly used for to Paul and placed before the infinitive
- **Answer: Je vais lui téléphoner ce soir.**

Question 7

- **B1** Je les vois demain à la gare. with les for plural direct object and placed before the conjugated verb vois
- **Answer: Je les vois demain à la gare.**

Question 8

- **B1** Tu lui rends les devoirs demain? with lui used for to the teacher (indirect object) and placed before the conjugated verb rends
- **Answer: Tu lui rends les devoirs demain?**

Question 9

- **B1** Il va la lire maintenant. with la for the feminine singular letter and placed before the infinitive lire
- **Answer: Il va la lire maintenant.**

Question 10

- **M1** Elle les a envoyées hier. with les placed before the auxiliary
- **A1** past participle agreement: envoyées with -es to agree feminine plural if les lettres is feminine plural
- **Answer: Elle les a envoyées hier.**

Question 11

- **M1** Je l'ai vu hier. with l' replacing le garçon and placed before the auxiliary
- **A1** no past participle agreement required for masculine singular, so vu is correct
- **Answer: Je l'ai vu hier.**

Question 12

- **M1** Nous les avons mangées hier. with les placed before the auxiliary
- **A1** past participle agreement: mangées feminine plural to agree with les pommes
- **Answer: Nous les avons mangées hier.**

Question 13

- **M1** correct futur proche or future tense form for 'will give': je vais donner or je donnerai
- **M1** correct indirect object pronoun placement: je vais lui donner or je lui donnerai, pronoun before infinitive or before verb in simple future
- **M1** correct noun for 'the book': le livre
- **A1** correct full sentence: Je vais lui donner le livre demain. or Je lui donnerai le livre demain.
- **Answer: Je vais lui donner le livre demain. (oe: Je lui donnerai le livre demain.)**

Question 14

- **M1** correct subject and verb agreement for 'they saw': Ils nous ont vus or Ils nous ont vu (see agreement)
- **M1** correct direct object pronoun 'nous' placed before the auxiliary
- **M1** correct past participle with agreement: vus with -s if 'nous' refers to a mixed or masculine plural group, or vue/vues if feminine singular/plural
- **M1** correct time and place 'à la gare hier' or 'hier à la gare' included
- **A1** a complete natural sentence such as Ils nous ont vus à la gare hier. with consistent agreement
- **Answer: Ils nous ont vus à la gare hier. (oe variants: Elles nous ont vues à la gare hier. depending on the gender of 'they' and 'us')**

Question 15

- **M1** correct perfect tense with auxiliary avoir: j'ai envoyé
- **M1** indirect object pronoun leur placed before the auxiliary: Je leur ai envoyé
- **A1** complete sentence: Je leur ai envoyé un mail ce matin. or Je leur ai envoyé un courriel ce matin.
- **Answer: Je leur ai envoyé un mail ce matin.**
