Question 1

- **M1** correct verb 'est' and structure Ma soeur est...
- **A1** généreuse with correct feminine agreement (allow a minor accent-only slip if the rest of the word is correct)
- **Answer: Ma soeur est très généreuse.**

Question 2

- **M1** reflexive verb s'entendre correctly conjugated: je m'entends
- **A1** bien avec mes parents oe avec ma famille if 'parents' is glossed as family in context
- **Answer: Je m'entends bien avec mes parents.**

Question 3

- **M1** time phrase L'année dernière at the start of the sentence
- **M1** correct perfect tense with avoir: a déménagé
- **A1** ma meilleure amie (or ami if male friend intended) correctly agreeing
- **Answer: L'année dernière, ma meilleure amie a déménagé.**

Question 4

- **M1** reflexive/reciprocal verb correctly conjugated: on se dispute oe nous nous disputons
- **A1** souvent placed correctly and pour/à propos de petites choses conveys 'about small things'
- **Answer: On se dispute souvent pour des petites choses. (oe: Nous nous disputons souvent à propos de petites choses.)**

Question 5

- **M1** futur proche correctly formed: va + infinitive (va étudier)
- **M1** à l'université for 'at university'
- **A1** l'année prochaine placed correctly for 'next year'
- **Answer: Mon frère va étudier à l'université l'année prochaine.**

Question 6

- **M1** comparative structure plus...que correctly used
- **A1** patiente with correct feminine agreement
- **Answer: Elle est plus patiente que sa soeur.**

Question 7

- **M1** correct present tense of envoyer: j'envoie
- **A1** à mes amis tous les jours correctly placed
- **Answer: J'envoie des messages à mes amis tous les jours.**

Question 8

- **M1** correct perfect tense with avoir: ont divorcé
- **M1** il y a deux ans correctly used for 'two years ago'
- **A1** mes parents as the subject, correctly placed
- **Answer: Mes parents ont divorcé il y a deux ans.**

Question 9

- **M1** correct object pronoun placement: m'écoute
- **M1** quand + present tense j'ai un problème
- **A1** toujours correctly placed and ma meilleure amie agreeing
- **Answer: Ma meilleure amie m'écoute toujours quand j'ai un problème.**

Question 10

- **M1** correct present tense of vouloir: nous voulons oe on veut
- **A1** passer plus de temps ensemble correctly used
- **Answer:** Nous voulons passer plus de temps ensemble. (oe: On veut passer plus de temps ensemble.)
