Where Spanish answers are required, accents, the enye and inverted punctuation have been omitted for print compatibility; students should write them correctly in exam conditions. This pack focuses on the indicative conditional tense for polite requests, advice and wishes.

Time guidance: 30 minutes.

- 1** Conjugate the verb 'tener' into the conditional tense for 'yo' in the context of a polite wish: 'I would have more time'. Give the single-word verb form only.

- 2** Conjugate the verb 'hacer' into the conditional tense for 'yo' as used in 'I would do that later'. Give the single-word form only.

(Total for Question 2 is 1 mark)

- 3** Conjugate the verb 'poder' into the conditional tense for 'yo' in the sentence 'I could help you' (polite). Give the single-word form only.

(Total for Question 3 is 1 mark)

- 4** Conjugate the verb 'poner' into the conditional tense for 'yo' in 'I would put it on the table'. Give the single-word form only.

(Total for Question 4 is 1 mark)

- 5 Conjugate the verb 'salir' into the conditional tense for 'yo' used in 'I would leave at nine'. Give the single-word form only.

(Total for Question 5 is 1 mark)

- 6 Conjugate the verb 'decir' into the conditional tense for 'yo' for 'I would say that...'. Give the single-word form only.

- 7 Conjugate the verb 'querer' into the conditional tense for 'yo' in 'I would want a new book'. Give the single-word form only.

- 8 Conjugate the verb 'haber' into the conditional tense for the impersonal form used in 'there would be' in a polite context. Give the single-word form only.

- 9 Match this irregular conditional stem to its infinitive in the context of conditional formation: 'tendr-'. Give the infinitive verb only.

- 10 Match this irregular conditional stem to its infinitive: 'har-'. Give the infinitive verb only.

17 Change this blunt present-tense request into a polite conditional request for use with a shop assistant. Context: customer asks a shop assistant for help. Original: '¿Puedes ayudarme?' Give the full sentence in Spanish conditional.

18 Change this blunt present-tense statement into a polite conditional request for a cafe. Context: customer to barista. Original: 'Quiero un cafe.' Give the full polite conditional Spanish sentence.

- 19** Change this direct present advice into conditional advice. Context: a friend gives advice about studying. Original: 'Debes estudiar mas.' Give the conditional 'should' phrasing used for softer advice in Spanish.

- 20** Change this direct present-tense instruction into a polite conditional used with an elderly neighbour. Context: asking a neighbour for permission. Original: 'Cierras la ventana.' Give the conditional polite sentence.

- 21** Translate into Spanish using the conditional: 'I would like to visit Barcelona next year.' Give a short sentence in Spanish.

- 23** Translate into Spanish using the conditional: 'There would be a problem if we left now.' Keep only the clause 'There would be a problem'.
